

Veszprém-Balaton 2023 European Capital of Culture

When Veszprém and the Bakony-Balaton region was awarded the title of European Capital of Culture 2023 in 2018, the project involved the institutions, cultural actors, and the NGOs of the city and the region. Due to the complexity of the European Capital of Culture program, with its colourful touristic and cultural offerings, and its sizable territorial scope, it is essential to bring in and cooperate with professional partners on the regional, national, and international levels.

The Veszprém-Balaton 2023 complex ECoC cultural project aims to reposition the region as a poweroriented cultural-creative
region of European visibility.

VEB2023 aims to create the opportunity to exploit the potential of the region and the city as a major cultural-creative region in Europe, and shape both its identity and perspectives in the short and long run.

In recent years, we have successfully laid the foundations for the program and are now involved in its implementation. Since 2020, we have launched numerous successful leadup events and initiatives (such as Veszprém-Balaton Filmpiknik that morphed into the Hungarian Motion Picture Festival, the Off-Season Literary Festival. or the Jutasi Piknik). We have also started joint efforts with the partner settlements of the region.

This year promises a lot of excitement, as we plan to organize several events and programs that will bring us closer still to achieving our longterm horizontal goals: to provide visitor-friendly and sustainable programs, as well as accessibility.


In 2022, VEB2023's ECoC program will be enriched by launching a total of ten packages whose final purpose is to develop and implement the 2023 program year, one that is understandable and accessible to all and is in line with the city's image.

- literary programs;
- analogue and digital fine arts;
- · the Cultural Landscape program;

- opportunities for community development and community building;
- horizontal goals.
